# Locations

With breathtaking panoramic views of the coastal mountain range, the Stawamus Chief and Howe Sound, the Sea to Sky Gondola is the perfect place to say, “I do”.

**SPRIT TRAIL LOOKOUT\***

Up to 100 guests (max. 40 seated)

An accessible platform at the Summit with views spanning Howe Sound and the vast mountain ranges. You can use the Sky Pilot Suspension Bridge as your aisle or walk down a beautiful forest path for a grand entrance to your ceremony.

**DIAMOND HEAD DECK\***

Up to 100 guests (max. 50 seated)

A covered outdoor space connected to the Diamond Head Room, offering panoramic views of Mount Garibaldi and a front-row seat to the gondolas moving along the mountainside.

\*The tent on the Diamond Head Deck is up from May–October and can be used as a contingency plan in case of inclement weather.

**HOWE SOUND LOOKOUT**

Up to 10 guests

If you are looking for an intimate setting with a grand view, this is it! A quick walk from the Summit Lodge will bring you to a rocky outcrop overlooking Howe Sound.

## WHAT IS INCLUDED?

The ceremony site from the selection in this package. Sea to Sky Gondola staff will provide and arrange the ceremony seating and a signing table 1 hour prior to the ceremony. The ceremony site will be closed to the public 30 minutes prior to the ceremony.

When hosting a reception, access to the reception area is provided 3 hours before the ceremony time. If earlier access is required, there is an additional hourly charge. The earliest upload is the time we open to the public.

Room set up including venue tables, chairs and table settings. White linens, and votive candles (three per table) can be included at the couple's request.

The awning of the Diamond Head Deck is available spring through fall. In the case of inclement weather during this timeframe, ceremonies can take place on the Diamond Head Deck (subject to some conditions for elopement ceremonies). For ceremonies taking place during the Off-Peak season, ceremonies must take place outdoors in all weather conditions. Any additional tents/weatherproofing required will be at the couple's expense.

An on-site supervisor during your event to support the couple and their designated wedding planner.

One complimentary site visit with a Sea to Sky Gondola events representative, as well as one unaccompanied rehearsal visit (with tickets for up to 10 people). Unused tickets are not transferable to guests or vendors on the event day. Tickets for any additional visits are available at a discounted rate.

Gondola tickets for the couple's invited guests (up to the package maximum) and 6 vendor tickets. Unlimited vendor tickets and meals for the wedding day are included when working with a preferred wedding planner.

Basic shipping requirements via the gondola cabins are included. Any items that do not fit in a regular gondola cabin can be shipped via the work carrier for an additional fee. Prior approval and coordination are required.

The Co-Pilot room is a private space within the Summit Lodge available for the wedding party to securely store personal belongings and touch up before the ceremony. This can be set up at no additional cost, and access is provided 2 hours prior to the ceremony start time.

Access to refrigerated storage for the wedding cake is available from the evening before the wedding and day of, free of charge. Any leftover cake must be brought down at the end of the event. Sea to Sky Gondola is not responsible for any cake left after the last download on the night of the event.

Parking passes for the couple, the wedding party, parents of the couple and vendors are included. We do have paid parking on site, couples can choose to cover guests parking passes or guests can pay on site.



# FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS?

**Q: Is a Wedding Planner Required?**

An accredited Wedding Planner is required for all weddings, excluding elopements. The wedding planner must be onsite from set up until tear down is completed. All planners are required to provide us with a Certificate of Insurance (min. liability of \$2,000,000) and proof of WorkSafe BC coverage. We can provide a list of preferred planners and suppliers to help you get started.

**Q: Are there any decoration restrictions we should be made aware of?**

Confetti, balloons, real or artificial flower petals, sparklers, smoke flares, and non-biodegradable sprinkles are not permitted onsite. Candles are only permitted indoors and enclosed candle holders. For use of bio-degradable alternatives, prior permission is required, and a cleaning fee may apply. Any décor that involves heights, ladders or installation/suspension of anything from the beams or ceiling must be done by Sea to Sky Gondola staff and additional charges will apply. Your wedding planner must consult with Sea to Sky Gondola staff on what is permitted on walls and wooden beams. Any forgotten décor must be inquired for within 72 hours after the event. Pick-

up must take place no longer than 5 days after the event. The Sea to Sky Gondola is not responsible for any décor left behind.

**Q: Are drones permitted?**

Drones and drone photography are not permitted.

**Q: When does alcohol service finish?**

Alcohol service will conclude 30 minutes before the end of an event. All guests must be on the gondola downloading by closing time. Wedding planners and vendors have one additional hour for tear down.

**Q: What is included in extended hours?**

For “Off-Peak” events that occur outside of regular operating hours, an additional facility rental fee applies. All lift attendants, medical personnel and security on site are included in the fee.

**Q: Do you have parking onsite?**

Parking is limited and therefore we encourage you to organize a shuttle service. Please see the “Preferred Vendors” list on our website. If your guests plan to arrive in private vehicles, parking is first come, first served. Vehicles can stay parked overnight with pick-up before 10 AM the following morning. Guests can pay for parking on the Pay-By-Phone app or in Guest Services.

**Q: Can we bring a wedding cake?**

Yes, you can bring a wedding cake.

**Q: Will Sea to Sky Gondola cut it for us?**

Yes, for cutting and plating of cake or arrangement of a dessert table or similar, an additional charge will apply.

**Q: What do you need to know about our vendors?**

Two weeks prior to your wedding we require a final vendor list which includes load in requirements, contact information, vendor meals and detailed inventory of all items being shipped. Large shipments need to be scheduled outside of regular hours of operation.

**Q: When do we need to submit our final numbers?**

One week prior to your wedding we require a final seating plan, a final guest count and an alphabetized guest list to facilitate distribution of tickets.

**Q: Can you smoke at the top of the mountain?**

The Sea to Sky Gondola, Summit Lodge and surrounding areas are entirely smoke and vape free. Guests wishing to smoke or vape are required to download from the Summit and head to the designated smoking area, then upload back to the Summit.

**Q: What is the contingency plan for the ceremony if it’s raining?**

The awning of the Diamond Head Deck is available spring through fall. In the case of inclement weather during this timeframe, ceremonies can take place on the Diamond Head Deck (subject to some conditions for elopement ceremonies). For ceremonies taking place during the Off-Peak season, ceremonies must take place outdoors in all weather conditions. Any additional tents/ weatherproofing required will be at the couple’s expense.

**Q: Can we create our own floorplans?**

We have established floorplans that suit our venue for various guest counts which can accommodate minor adjustments.

**Q: Are pets allowed for the ceremony or reception?**

We don’t allow pets for weddings, ceremonies and elopements. For more details, please visit our pet policy here [www.seatoskygondola.com/dog-policy/](http://www.seatoskygondola.com/dog-policy/)

**Q: What equipment do you have that we can rent from you?**

We have a microphone & speaker, fixed projector & screen and arch available to rent.

**Q: Can we have alcohol at the ceremony site?**

Outside alcohol is not permitted. Alcohol is not permitted on the ceremony site. Alcohol consumption is only permitted in licensed areas of the Diamond Head Room, Diamond Head Deck, Sky Pilot Deck and Octagon Deck.

**Q: Can we bring our own alcohol or wine?**

Outside alcohol is not permitted on site. Commercially prepared wine can be brought in for a corkage fee. Applicable taxes and gratuities apply. Please contact the Sales team for more information.

**Q: When do food and beverage selections need to be submitted?**

Food selections should be submitted 6 weeks before the wedding date. 30 days before your wedding, we will also need the list of allergies and dietary restrictions, and bar selections.

**Q: How does the payment process work?**

A 20% non-refundable deposit and signed contract is required based on the estimated event cost to confirm you wedding date. 50% of estimated costs due 6 months before the event. Any remaining estimated balance is due 30 days before the event. After the wedding

the final remaining balance is due seven days after the invoice is issued. If final payment is not received by the due date, the credit card on file will be automatically billed for the outstanding balance. Late payments incur a 2.5% weekly interest charge.

**Q: What taxes and gratuity charges can we expect on our event?**

A 5% Federal Goods and Services Tax (GST) will be applied to all food, beverages, services, service charges, and venue rental. A 7% Provincial Sales Tax (PST) will be applied to all rental items. A 10% Provincial Liquor Tax will be applied to all alcoholic beverages. All applicable taxes are subject to change. Gratuities will be applied to all food and beverage services. Minimum spends do not include taxes and gratuities.
