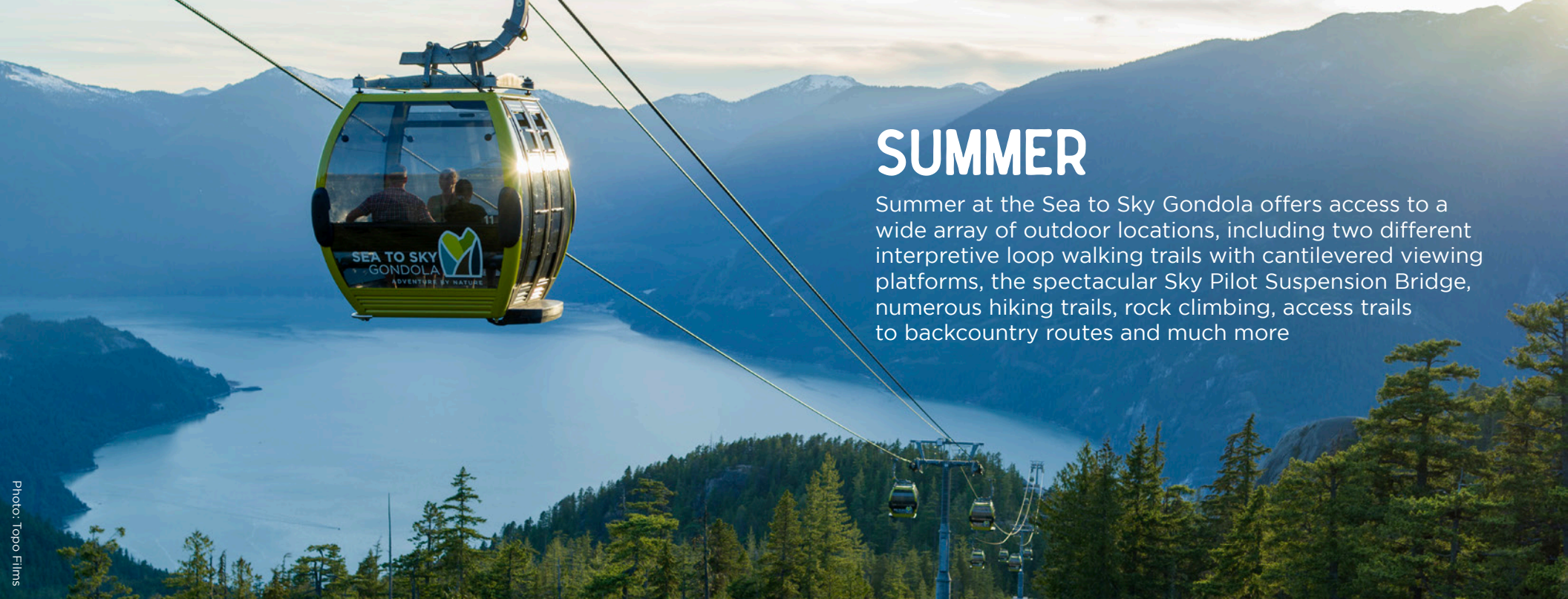

GONDOLA STATISTICS

- 39 cabins + 1 freight carrier
- 8-person capacity per cabin
- Moves up to 1200 guests per hour
- Wheelchair accessible
- 1410 lbs. / 640 KG load capacity
- Average one-way trip time, 12 minutes

EQUIPMENT/LOGISTICS

- Pick up truck
- Side by Side ATV (with tracks in winter)
- Snowcat Groomer
- Excavator
- Backhoe
- Snowblowers

ROAD ACCESS Summer only

- 11km forest service road provides access to the summit for items that cannot be shipped by gondola/freight carrier
- 4x4 vehicles only
- Use & access requires approval

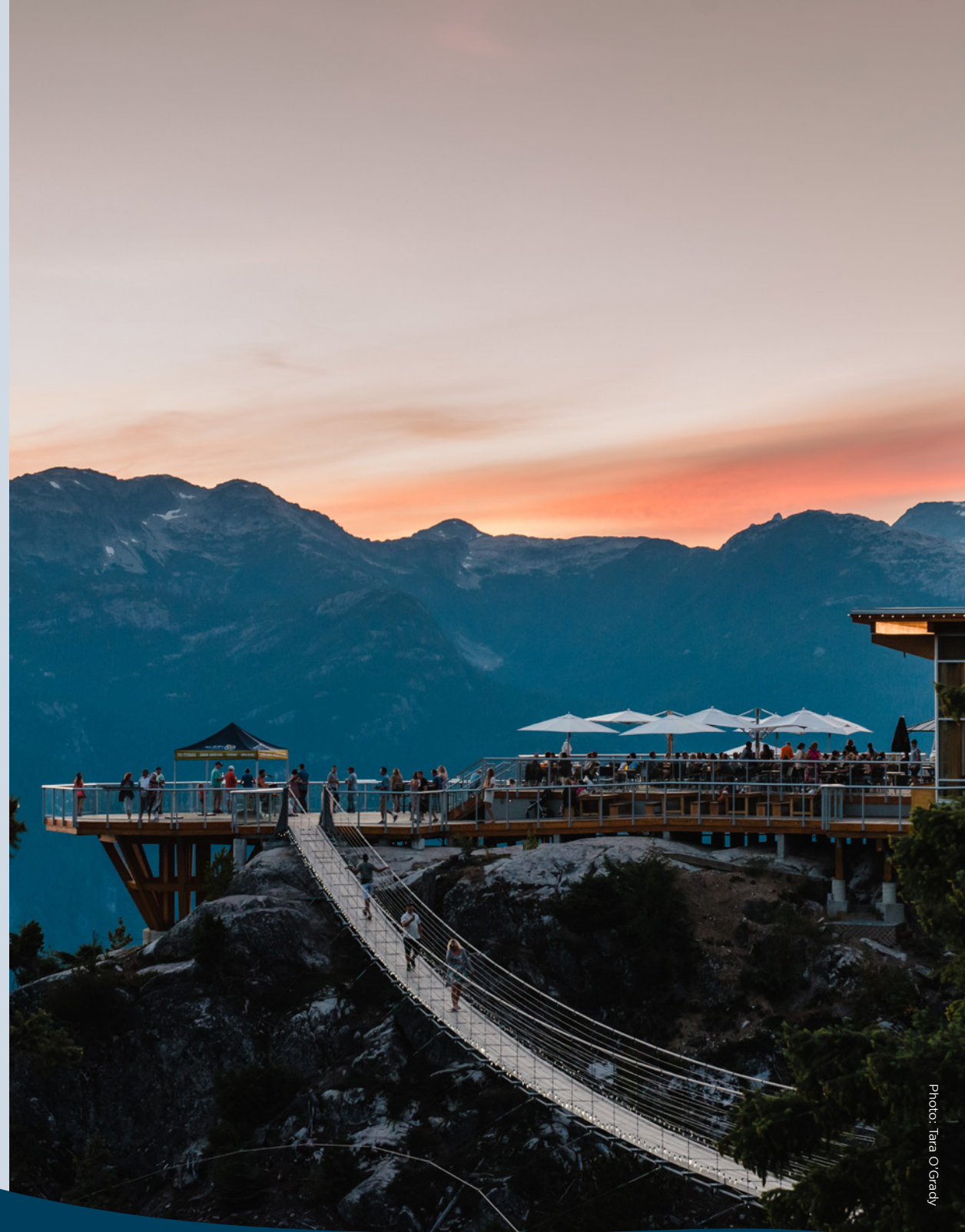

THE SKY PILOT SUSPENSION BRIDGE

- 87 metres long
- 1 metre wide
- 30 metres above ground
- 885 metres above sea level
- Viewing platforms on both ends

SUMMIT LODGE FACILITIES

At the top of the gondola, adjacent to the gondola terminal, is the 9,000 square-foot Summit Lodge. The design of the lodge offers floor to ceiling windows and huge Douglas fir beams making for a perfect place to enjoy the views. Within the lodge you'll find a gift shop, cafeteria-style eatery, a full-service bar, and a private function space.
